Buzz Worthy

Hot Coffee: While most people prefer their lattes sweet and creamy, that's not the case at a coffee shop in Ganzhou, Jiangxi Province, China. A bold new flavour—chili—is exciting the taste buds of customers there! In tribute to the region's love for spicy cuisine, Jingshi Coffee Cafe decided to try something different. Baristas now add dried chili to their iced "Spicy Latte," finishing it off with a light sprinkle of chili powder. Though it sounds fiery, some find the drink surprisingly smooth and pleasant. Buyers beware, though—locals are no strangers to heat!

That's a bold move! Zhu, a woman from Xiangyang in China's Hubei province, owns a trucking company. Wanting to avoid her trucks being pulled over and fined by police for various reasons, she took matters into her own hands. Zhu bought six GPS trackers online and secretly attached them to police vehicles parked outside the local station. Unfortunately for her, the police soon discovered the small black boxes and traced the SIM cards inside. That led them straight to Zhu. As a result, she was fined 500 Yuan (CNY) and sentenced to eight days in jail.

Different Pet: Tiffany Pierre and Gregory Guiot, a couple from Belgium's Wallonia region, don't have the usual pets like dogs or cats. Instead, they share their home with a boar. The couple lovingly call him Oscar, though they never planned to keep him. Guiot found him as a tiny piglet in the forest and brought him home out of compassion, hoping to place him in a shelter. Over a year later, Oscar still lives with them and now weighs 80 kg (176 lbs). He's house-trained, has his own couch, and is very much considered a part of the family.

Coin-Operated Charm: In the heart of Queens, New York (USA), there's a unique home that once buzzed with washers and dryers. Today, Sampson Dahl lives in this former laundromat, transforming it into a vibrant community hub. Filled with quirky decor from his work as a set designer, the 800-square-foot (75-square-meter) space also serves as an arts venue. The front room doubles as a stage and salon for events like painting nights and live music, often attended by friends and locals. Occasionally, passersby step inside, mistaking Dahl's creative home for a working laundromat, lured by the vintage storefront awning.

Tomato Trouble: A Nigerian woman may face a long prison sentence over an online complaint about a can of tomato purée. Chioma Okoli took to social media to criticize the product's overly sweet taste. Her post quickly went viral, drawing thousands of reactions. Despite warnings from someone linked to the company, she continued posting her criticism. As a result, Okoli was arrested under Nigeria's cybercrime laws. The company is now suing her for major damages, claiming her posts could harm their business. In response, Okoli is fighting back by filing lawsuits against both the company and the police.

Did You Know?

- Did you know that wombat poop is cube-shaped? This unusual trait helps keep their droppings from rolling away, which is useful since they use them to mark territory. The shape is created by the way their intestines contract during digestion. Scientists believe this cube shape is a result of dry diets and a slow digestive process that can take up to two weeks!
- Did you know that jellyfish can technically live forever? A species called *Turritopsis dohrnii*, often referred to as the "immortal jellyfish," has the rare ability to revert its cells back to an earlier stage of life. This means it can potentially start its life cycle over again and again, avoiding natural death unless killed by predators or disease.
- Did you know that plants can "talk" to each other using underground fungi networks? Called the "Wood Wide Web," these mycorrhizal networks allow plants to send signals and even nutrients to one another. Some trees warn their neighbors of pests, while others support weaker plants by sharing carbon through the fungal roots.
- Did you know that your bones are constantly being replaced? Your skeleton completely regenerates itself roughly every 10 years through a process called bone remodeling. Old bone cells are broken down and replaced with new ones, meaning the bones you have now weren't exactly the same a decade ago!

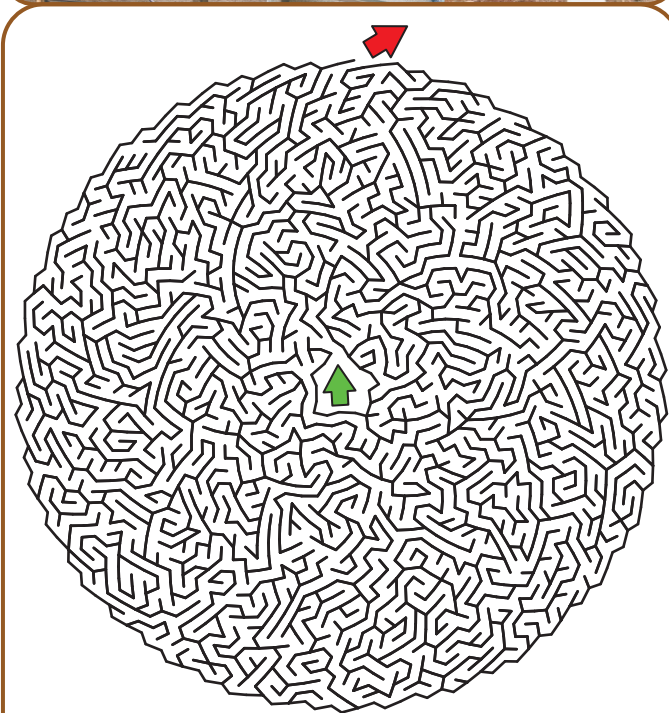
