Hot Coffee: While most people prefer their lattes sweet and creamy, customers at a coffee shop in Ganzhou, Jiangxi Province, China, are craving something bolder. A new chili-infused flavor is stirring up excitement at Jingshi Coffee Cafe. Inspired by the region's love for spicy food, the café decided to try something different. Baristas now serve an iced "Spicy Latte" made with dried chili and topped with a light sprinkle of chili powder. Despite its fiery ingredients, some customers find the flavor surprisingly smooth and mild. Still, buyers beware—locals are well accustomed to heat!

Skyward Rent: Faced with Vancouver's competitive rental market, Tim Chen found a creative solution. The Calgary arts student opted for an unusual commute—flying to class instead of paying steep rent in the city. After his rent increased, Chen realized that booking flights was actually more affordable. By living with his parents and attending just two classes a week, he manages to cut housing costs by more than half compared to renting in Vancouver. As housing prices continue to rise, Chen's unconventional choice highlights the extreme lengths some Canadians go to in order to make ends meet.

Monkey Trouble: For years, visitors to Lopburi, Thailand, have enjoyed interacting with the monkeys that roam freely around the temple grounds. But now, frustrated city officials have decided it's time to relocate the mischievous macaques. Roughly 2,500 of the monkeys will be moved to large enclosures away from populated areas. The decision comes after a recent incident in which monkeys chased a woman for her food, kicking her in the back and causing a motorcyclist to crash. To prevent harm to both people and animals, authorities are taking action to remove the playful primates from the temple grounds.

Historical Gaming: In a modern twist on traditional teaching, a middle school teacher is gaining online attention for using video games as a classroom tool. Mr. Mahathey introduced the game Assassin's Creed Odyssey during a unit on ancient Greece. A video of his lesson went viral after he used the game to illustrate the Battle of Thermopylae. Did You Know?

1. Did you know that octopuses have three hearts and blue blood? Two of their hearts pump blood to the gills, while the third heart pumps it to the rest of the body. Interestingly, when they swim, the heart that delivers blood to the body actually stops beating! Their blue blood is due to a copper-rich protein called hemocyanin, which helps them survive in the cold, low-oxygen waters of the deep sea.

2. Did you know that honey never spoils, even after thousands of years? Archaeologists have discovered pots of honey in ancient Egyptian tombs that are over 3,000 years old and still perfectly edible. Honey's low moisture content, natural acidity, and presence of hydrogen peroxide make it an environment where bacteria and microbes can't survive, allowing it to last indefinitely when sealed properly.

3. Did you know that the Eiffel Tower can grow more than 6 inches taller in the summer? This iconic Paris monument is made of iron, which expands when exposed to heat. During hot days, thermal expansion causes the metal structure to stretch and the tower to become noticeably taller, only to shrink back down in colder weather.

4. Did you know that there are more trees on Earth than stars in the Milky Way galaxy? NASA estimates there are between 100 and 400 billion stars in our galaxy. In contrast, scientists have calculated that Earth is home to over 3 trillion trees. While deforestation is a growing concern, this surprising fact highlights the vastness and importance of our planet's forest ecosystems.

5. Did you know that the human nose can detect over 1 trillion different scents? While once believed to recognize only about 10,000 smells, recent research shows our olfactory system is far more powerful. Your brain processes complex combinations of molecules to identify and remember scents—sometimes even linking them to memories and emotions within seconds.

6. Did you know that an ancient virus was revived after being frozen for 48,500 years? In 2022, scientists discovered and revived a 48,500-year-old virus from Siberian permafrost, making it the oldest "zombie virus" ever brought back to life. Found in ice samples buried deep beneath the frozen landscape, this discovery raises questions about how climate change might awaken long-dormant microbes that have been trapped for millennia. While the virus only infects single-celled organisms, researchers warn that melting ice could potentially release ancient pathogens that once threatened prehistoric life.

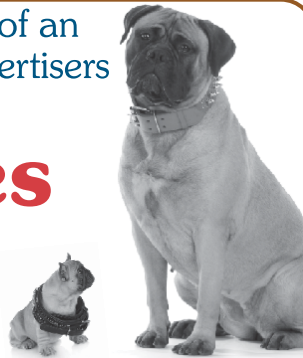




