## Everyone's Talking

**Crazy Road:** The Huangjuewan Overpass in Chongqing, southwest China, is a traffic structure reputed to be among the most complex in the world. Seen from above, it resembles an octopus with tentacles extending in eight different directions. The overpass connects three important thoroughfares with five levels of roadway, twenty ramps, and several lanes. In 2017, following more than ten years of planning and building, it was finally opened to traffic. The designers argue that despite its appearance, it is not as complicated as it seems because effective signage maintains traffic flow. Drivers can navigate through the structure even with satellite navigation.

**Lights Out:** An electrician from Ganeshpur, a village in India's Purnia region of Bihar, took advantage of his electrical expertise. Just after dark, he would turn off the village's electricity so that he could meet his lover in the playground, all while maintaining the secrecy of their connection. **Square Trees:** Whether they are oak, ash, aspen, cypress, or any other species, most people would assume that tree trunks are cylindrical. However, visitors to El Valle de Anton, Panama, might be shocked to learn that a certain type of cottonwood tree thrives in one region of the nation with square trunks—the rings inside the trunk are even square. The region is known as the Valley of Square Trees and is situated next to El Valle, a sizable dormant volcano. While the trunks of some of these trees have square shapes that are less noticeable, others have perfect squares with precise angles. As the trees get older, they appear to grow less square and more resemble the conventional rounded shape.

However, an elderly widow from Looe in Cornwall, England, got the surprise of her long life when she discovered her late husband's wedding ring in the garden after it had been lost for 35 years.
