# **Buzz Worthy**

Windy Ride: Most people prefer calm weather for biking to avoid being slowed down by strong winds. However, for those who enjoy a challenge, the Dutch Headwind Time Trial Championship offers a unique experience. Participants compete on identical upright, single-speed bikes. The race takes place on the Oosterscheldekering storm barrier, near the southwestern Dutch city of Vrouwenpolder, covering a distance of 8.5 kilometers (5.3 miles). First held in 2013, the event only occurs during storms when winds reach up to 120 km/h (74 mph). The winner is the cyclist who completes the course in the shortest time, with a maximum of 300 competitors allowed.

Amusing Bird: Some people enjoy keeping chickens as pets, and LOW RATES-MORE BUYERS-SELL YOUR HOME FAST! the Ayam Ketawa is a popular yet expensive breed. Its name, which means "laughing chicken," comes from its unique ability to mimic human laughter. Originating in Indonesia, these birds are also known as "longcrowers." In Indonesia, enthusiasts can join breed-specific groups and even enter their chickens into competitions where their laughter-like crowing is judged.

Ice Cream Haven: In Havana, both locals and tourists can enjoy unlimited ice cream at Parque Coppelia for an exceptionally low price. Often referred to as the "ice cream cathedral" or catedral de helado, this iconic spot serves an astonishing 30,000 ice cream lovers daily. At any given time, up to 600 people of all ages may be waiting for their share of the sweet treat. As the world's largest ice cream pavilion, Parque Coppelia spans an entire city block and has become a cherished Cuban tradition. Since its opening in 1966, it has remained a beloved destination for ice cream enthusiasts.

Vibrating Diet Pill: Researchers at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology have developed a groundbreaking high-tech diet pill that vibrates after being swallowed. Known as the Vibrating Ingestible BioElectronic Stimulator (VIBES), this device stimulates stomach receptors to create a sensation of fullness. Featured in the journal Science Advances, VIBES is considered a potential breakthrough in weight-loss technology. Initial testing on pigs showed that just 30 minutes of vibration reduced food intake by 40%, though human trials have yet to begin. The device works by activating stretch receptors in the stomach, prompting the hypothalamus to release chemicals that signal satiety. This innovative approach could offer a unique and engaging method for weight management.

1. Did you know that there's a massive "waterfall" under the ocean? Beneath the Denmark Strait, between Greenland and Iceland, lies the world's largest underwater waterfall. This natural phenomenon occurs due to the temperature difference between Arctic and Atlantic waters. The colder, denser water from the Arctic sinks beneath the warmer, lighter water from the Atlantic, creating a cascading effect that plunges over 3,500 meters (11,500 feet)—nearly three times deeper than Angel Falls, the tallest waterfall on land!

2. Did you know that an ancient virus was revived after being frozen for 48,500 years? In 2022, scientists discovered and revived a 48,500-year-old virus from Siberian permafrost, making it the oldest "zombie virus" ever brought back to life. Found in ice samples buried deep beneath the frozen landscape, this discovery raises questions about how climate change might awaken long-dormant microbes that have been trapped for millennia. While the virus only infects single-celled organisms, researchers warn that melting ice could potentially release ancient pathogens that once threatened prehistoric life.

3. Did you know that a year on Venus is shorter than a day on Earth? Venus has an incredibly slow rotation, taking 243 Earth days to complete just one full spin on its axis. However, it orbits the Sun faster, completing a full revolution in just 225 Earth days. This means that a single day on Venus (from one sunrise to the next) is actually longer than an entire Venusian year! Even more bizarre, Venus rotates in the opposite direction of most planets, meaning the Sun rises in the west and sets in the east.

4. Did you know that trees can communicate with each other through a "wood wide web"? Trees in forests are not solitary beings they are connected by underground networks of fungi known as mycorrhizal networks. These fungi help trees exchange nutrients, warn each other about dangers like insect infestations, MAKE YOUR OLD SOFA NEW and even support weaker or younger trees by sharing resources. Some scientists refer to this as the "wood wide web" because it functions much like the internet, allowing trees to send and receive vital information for survival.

5. Did you know that sharks predate trees and even the rings of Saturn? Sharks have been swimming in Earth's oceans for over 400 million years, meaning they existed long before trees evolved around 350 million years ago. Even more mind-blowing, Saturn's famous rings are estimated to be only about 100 million years old meaning sharks were already thriving in the seas before those icy rings formed around the gas giant. These ancient predators have survived five mass extinctions, adapting over time while still retaining their prehistoric legacy.


