Buzz Worthy

Sausage stop: You might be used to buying chocolate bars or chips from a vending machine, but in Germany, you can also grab bratwurst and bockwurst sausages. These unusual vending machines have been around for a few years and are both popular and convenient, especially late at night when cravings hit. People who work late also appreciate them if grocery stores are closed by the time they can shop. Some machines even carry eggs, milk, fruit, butter, and ready-made sides like potato salad. To ensure safety, the machines are temperature-controlled, and the products are vacuum-sealed.

Lucky snake: After being missing for more than a year from its home in Spennymoor, England, a beloved pet snake suddenly turned up on the roof of a neighbor's garage. Locals and an animal welfare officer suggested that a crow might have accidentally carried the snake before dropping it due to its size and weight. The resilient 3-foot (0.9-meter) reptile endured the ordeal, surviving harsh winter temperatures as well as the bird encounter. Snakes are ectothermic, meaning they depend on their surroundings for warmth, which makes its survival even more remarkable. Its owners, who had long feared the worst, were overjoyed and relieved by its unexpected return.

Bird blockade: Trains between Brighton and London, England, were delayed for at least ninety minutes for an unusual reason: a baby herring gull had to be removed from the tracks. During the rescue, officials shut off power to the rail line. Although herring gulls are a common sight in Brighton, a seaside town, they are on the Birds of Conservation Concern's red list due to their declining numbers. Many passengers at first assumed the cause of the delay was a joke. Despite their frustration, they were relieved to learn the young bird had been safely rescued and was unharmed.

Early graduation: Dorothy Jean Tillman II is among the rare few to finish college by the age of 17. She earned her doctorate in integrated behavioral health in 2024 as part of the graduating class at Arizona State University (ASU) in Phoenix, Arizona (U.S.). Dorothy was homeschooled in Chicago during her early years and began taking college courses by correspondence at the age of ten. Over the next seven years, she studied at three different universities before completing her degree at ASU. According to the university, she is the youngest person in its history to receive a doctorate in integrated behavioral health. Her remarkable achievement stands as inspiration for young scholars around the world.

Barrow blitz: Reaching a top speed of 52 mph (84 km/h), Dylan Phillips, a technician from Pembrokeshire, England, set a new Guinness World Record for the fastest wheelbarrow. What started as an idea at a pub quickly became reality when he built the wheelbarrow in his shed. After hitting 37 mph (59 km/h) during a test run, he set his sights on the world record, which stood at 46 mph (74 km/h). Phillips broke the record at the Straightliners Speed Week with his homemade creation. Despite its impressive speed, the wheelbarrow is unsafe, with only front-wheel brakes and no suspension. Phillips admitted the ride was both uncomfortable and terrifying.

Did You Know?

1. Space growth: Did you know that astronauts actually grow taller in space? Living in microgravity causes the spine to stretch because there's no gravity pulling it downward. This change can increase their height by up to 3%. That means a man who is 6 feet tall on Earth could return from space nearly 2 inches (5 cm) taller. However, this effect is temporary—once astronauts return to Earth, gravity compresses their spine again, bringing them back to their normal height.

2. Avocado truth: You might not think of avocados as fruit in the same way as apples, oranges, or bananas, but biologically, that's exactly what they are. Since avocados grow from flowers and contain a seed, they are classified as a fruit, more specifically a single-seeded berry. What makes them special is that, unlike most fruits which are rich in sugars, avocados are packed with healthy unsaturated fats. These fats help support heart health, reduce bad cholesterol, and provide long-lasting energy, which makes avocados a superfood favorite around the world.

3. Frightening frog: The tiny poison dart frog, measuring only about 1 inch (2.5 cm), carries a deadly secret in its skin. Despite its small size, it has enough poison to kill as many as 20,000 mice—or even several large animals. This toxin is stored safely in its body and serves as a powerful defense against predators. These frogs are known for their bright and striking colors, which act as a warning sign to stay away. Native to Central and South America, they are among the most dangerous creatures in the animal kingdom despite their miniature appearance.
