Food History: Visit the LA Plaza Cocina museum if you're someone who appreciates food history as well as culinary arts. LA Plaza Cocina, which calls itself the first museum devoted to Mexican food and is a part of the broader cultural institution LA Plaza de Cultura y Artes, aims to shed light on the lengthy history of the cuisine. View historical tools and utensils and learn how maize and other ingredients became staples in the nation's cuisine at this venue in downtown Los Angeles, California (U.S.). 
