## Everyone's Talking

**Food History:** Visit the LA Plaza Cocina museum if you're someone who appreciates food history as well as culinary arts. LA Plaza Cocina, which calls itself the first museum devoted to Mexican food and is a part of the broader cultural institution LA Plaza de Cultura y Artes, aims to shed light on the lengthy history of the cuisine. View historical tools and utensils and learn how maize and other ingredients became staples in the nation's cuisine at this venue in downtown Los Angeles, California (U.S.). In addition to having a store with cookbooks, souvenirs, and traditional cookware for making traditional Mexican dishes, the museum also provides culinary workshops.

**Bats & Bugs:** Two libraries in Portugal that house priceless manuscripts dating back hundreds of years have found an amazing solution to prevent insects from destroying the pages of their books. Bat colonies reside in the rafters and dive down at night to devour flies and other pests. The National Palace of Mafra library, located close to Lisbon, and the Joanina Library at the University of Coimbra in central Portugal, are believed to have been the bats' long-term homes. Their arrival has always been appreciated. The bats at both libraries return to the libraries to roost after leaving through open windows in search of water. The establishments have a natural method of protecting their priceless, historic treasures thanks to these bat colonies.

**Big Bucks:** While most boarding schools are not as costly as Institut Le Rosey in Switzerland, some are. Students from all around the world are accepted as long as their parents are able to cover the CHF 87,000–119,000 tuition. During the spring, summer, and fall semesters, the school's two campuses are housed on the Chateau du Rosey estate near Rolle, while the winter term is spent at the Gstaad ski resort. Established in 1880, the coeducational Institut Le Rosey boasts a plethora of renowned alumni, comprising global leaders, princes, and monarchs. The age range of the students at this elite school is 8 to 18, and many of them go on to attend esteemed colleges.

**Artist who adored cats:** There's no denying that London, England-born Louis Wain (1860–1939) was a cat lover. He enjoyed painting and drawing cats. He would give the cats a humorous, human touch, seeing them carol-singing, dancing on their hind feet, playing musical instruments, and giving speeches. The artist was admitted to Bethlem Royal Hospital in southeast England for a few years. His artwork is on display in the hospital. "The Electrical Life of Louis Wain" is the title of a recently released movie that chronicles the artist's life. English actors Benedict Cumberbatch and Claire Foy played Wain's wife, Emily, and Wain, respectively.


