A rock and a hard place: A certain boulder in Norway is only brave enough to step onto. "Kjeragbolten" is stuck in a crevasse on the 1,084-foot (3,556-meter) Kjerag mountain in southern Norway, close to the town of Lysebotn. The rock faces an abyss that rises roughly 1,000 meters (3,280 feet) above the Lysefjord below it. Although jumping down onto it is not for the timid, many people succeed in doing so and capture an amazing picture. If they are in decent physical condition, adventurers can hike a 12-kilometer (7.5-mile) trail to reach Kjeragbolten. Without scaling the renowned boulder, the scenery is still worth the effort.

Sparkly crime: What revealed them was the glitter. Because the sparkly material was all over the inside of the two Florida (U.S.) women's cars, police were able to link them to a crime. Tiny tail: People in Japan have adored one particular breed of cat for generations. Known by the name Japanese bobtail, this cat has a tail that resembles a bunny's but is significantly shorter than those of other breeds. They can leap to high perches and have powerful hind legs. In the past, these cats were highly valued for their capacity to manage the rodent population, particularly in silkworm barns. They also prevented rats from getting near rice paper scrolls in temples. They are regarded as charming, perceptive creatures that make wonderful companions and can even be trained to fetch! With them, owners can engage in "conversations" since they like to react vocally. The Japanese bobtail is a rare breed that is expensive to buy from a breeder and is only found in Japan.

Floridian Flamingo: When visiting the U.S. state of Florida, tourists quickly learn that the pink birds known as flamingos—which have long necks and spindly legs—are a common sight. Thus, it makes sense that the Tampa International Airport has an art installation honoring that bird. The sculpture, named "HOME," was made by artist Matthew Mazzotta and features an enormous likeness of the pink creature. Standing at a height of 21 feet (6.4 meters), it seems to be lowering its neck into the water to feed at eye level with onlookers; the surface of the water is visible close to the airport ceiling. This optical illusion is produced by special lighting in the ceiling. It is encouraged for visitors to touch and engage with this fascinating work of art.
